Edinburgh Award (Peer Learning and Support Volunteers: Students as Change Agents)

This award is given to students whom the University has recognised for actively working to maximise their impact and excel as a change agent. These students have worked in interdisciplinary groups addressing a complex real-world challenge for social good, as set by external industry and sector experts.

In successfully completing the Edinburgh Award, these students will have been helped to:

- increase their self-awareness;
- make the most of their existing strengths and build new skills/abilities against clear development goals;
- understand the processes involved in having a planned positive impact and strategically working to excel, enabling them to have impact and make a difference whatever situation they are in; and
- look not only at their personal role in a global-society, but also to capitalise on their experiences elsewhere to inform and enhance their role as a change agent, and *vice versa*.
