Edinburgh Award (Chemical Physics: Student Leaders)

This award is given to students of Chemical Physics in the School of Chemistry whom the University has recognised for actively working to maximise their impact and excel as a student leader. In successfully completing the Edinburgh Award, these students will have been helped to:

- increase their self-awareness;

- understand the processes involved in having a planned positive impact and strategically working to excel, enabling them to have impact and make a difference whatever situation they are in; and
- look not only at their leadership role, but also to capitalise on their experiences elsewhere to inform and enhance their role as a student leader, and vice versa.
