Edinburgh Award (Physics and Astronomy: Maths Buddies)

This award is given to students whom the University has recognised for actively working to maximise their impact and excel as a Maths Buddy. These students developed and led a buddy scheme with the primary aim to help and support the teaching and learning of Mathematics, with particular focus on problem solving by using Mathematical Methods

In successfully completing the Edinburgh Award, these students will have been helped to:

- increase their self-awareness;
- make the most of their existing strengths and build new skills/abilities against clear development goals;
- understand the processes involved in having a planned positive impact and strategically working to excel, enabling them to have impact and make a difference whatever situation they are in; and
- look not only at their volunteering as a Maths Buddy, but also to capitalise on their experiences elsewhere to inform and enhance their role as a Maths Buddy, and vice versa.
