

Edinburgh Award (School of Mathematics: Curriculum Ambassadors)

This award is given to students in the School of Mathematics whom the University has recognised for actively working to maximise their impact and excel as a maths ambassador. These students have volunteered their time to deliver classes in partner secondary schools to ensure a broad curriculum experience for pupils.

In successfully completing the Edinburgh Award, these students will have been helped to:

- increase their self-awareness:
- make the most of their existing strengths and build new skills/abilities against clear development goals;
- understand the processes involved in having a planned positive impact and strategically working to excel, enabling them to have impact and make a difference whatever situation they are in; and
- look not only at ambassadorial role, but also to capitalise on their experienced elsewhere to inform and enhance their role as an ambassador and *vice versa*.
