Edinburgh Award (Sports Union Volunteers: Leadership)

This Award is given to students within the Sports Union whom the University has recognised for actively working to maximise their impact and excel as a student leader. In successfully completing the Edinburgh Award, these students will have been helped to:

- understand the processes involved in having a planned positive impact and strategically working to excel, enabling them to have impact and make a difference whatever situation they are in; and
- look not only at their leadership role, but also to capitalise on their experiences elsewhere to inform and enhance their role as a volunteer, and vice versa.
