Edinburgh Award (Students' Association: Representing Students)

This award is given to students whom the University has recognised for actively working to maximise their impact and excel as a Student Representative through the Students' Association. These students have helped to enhance the university by building links between students and various levels of the institution, ensuring the University is engaging with students to improve teaching, learning, assessment, and academic services.

In successfully completing the Edinburgh Award, these students will have been helped to:

- increase their self-awareness;
- make the most of their existing strengths and build new skills/abilities against clear development goals;
- understand the processes involved in having a planned positive impact and strategically working to excel, enabling them to have impact and make a difference whatever situation they are in; and
- look not only at their student representation role, but also to capitalise on their experiences elsewhere to inform and enhance their role as a Student representative, and *vice versa*.
